Power wheelchair drive controls are constantly evolving with the advancement of technology. There is a wide range of proportional controls that can truly enhance the consumers independent mobility in order to achieve their ADL's.

This class will provide evaluating clinicians and other seating/mobility professionals with the knowledge of the various proportional drive control options, what these options require to utilize them and how they can be modified to meet the everyday needs of the consumer.
